## Key aspects of North Stelton NEXT

#### **Healing & Spiritual Renewal**

#### Prioritize Prayer and Fasting

- Weekly corporate prayer gatherings.
- · Church-wide fasting initiatives to seek God's direction and unit.
  - o New Year Daniel Fast
  - Lenten Season Fast

#### Deepen Worship Experiences

- Evaluate the current worship format and enhance it by incorporating diverse music styles, creative elements (drama, visual arts), and testimonies.
- Trainings for worship participants to ensure excellence and authenticity.

#### Enhance Preaching and Teaching

- Develop various sermons and sermon series that address the congregation's spiritual needs and challenges.
- Offer Bible studies, prayer calls, and small group opportunities to encourage deeper learning and fellowship.
- Reimagine Church School to increase Bible-based teaching and biblical development

#### In-reach & Member Engagement

#### Improve Communication

- Use modern communication tools (emails, social media, text alerts) to keep members informed and connected.
- Regularly celebrate milestones and achievements within the congregation.
- Utilize Church Bulletin as a means for ministry-specific information sharing
- Digitize & frequently update church calendar.

#### Foster a Sense of Belonging

- Organize fellowship events, such as potlucks, game nights, or other social activities.
- Create support groups for various life stages (e.g., young adults, singles, widows/widowers, seniors).
- Greeters ministry to welcome existing members, new members, reconnecting members, and visitors to our church.
- Ensure steps for new members to grow in their faith through membership classes and ministry opportunities.

#### Encourage Service and Volunteerism

- Highlight service opportunities during worship and online.
- Recognize and appreciate volunteers regularly.
- Collaborate with other area organizations to solicit or partner on volunteer programs

#### Sick & Shut In

- Maintain up-to-date sick & shut in database.
- Regular communication with homebound members
- Organize miniature caravans to offer in-person support to sick and homebound members, when appropriate.

#### **Outreach & Community Initiatives**

- Identify areas where the church can make an impact.
- Highlight and support existing efforts like the soup kitchen and food pantry.
- Launch initiatives like tutoring for students, financial literacy workshops, or health clinics.
- Host community events such as movie nights, festivals, etc. to attract visitors.
- Organize outreach campaigns such as door-to-door visits, community canvassing.

#### Stewardship & Operational Efficiency

- Review the church's administrative, financial, and operational systems for areas of improvement.
- Create a transparent budgeting process with input from key leaders.
- Launch fundraising initiatives for specific needs (e.g., building upgrades, missions).

#### Facilities & Temple Management

- Evaluate the condition of the church building and address maintenance needs.
- Ensure the church is welcoming, clean, and equipped with modern technology.

#### **Invest in Youth and Children**

- Strengthen children's and youth ministries with engaging, age-appropriate programming.
- Facilitate and encourage intergenerational mentoring to bridge the gap between older and younger members.
- Promote and support YPD "Super Saturday" efforts
- Support youth academic achievements through recognition and scholarships
- Identify a youth minister to assist with spiritual development of children and youth
- Children's moments during select worship services
- Establish acolyte ministry.
